We encourage every Christian here to use their God-given gifts and talents to serve others. In no way do we want to restrict anyone from serving in those areas where they are both gifted and passionate. Having said that, we do not want anything done here that is outside the purpose and mission of this congregation. We remind you that we exist both as individual Christians and as a church to glorify God in all that we do. In everything that we do, we want it to be such that it results in being:

Grounded in the truths of God's Word;
Growing in love for one another and the world;
Godly in our personal lives; and
Going forth to share Christ and serve others.

Any ministry must meet these criteria to be approved. We have a simple approval process that requires the following:

1. Pick up a Ministry Proposal Form (MPF) from the office. Write out your ministry idea using the questions on the form:
 - a. **What** is your ministry idea?
 - b. **Why** do we need to be involved in this ministry?
 - c. **When** would this ministry take place?
 - d. **How** would this ministry be implemented and operated?
 - e. **Who** will lead this ministry?

If needed, examples of other proposed ministries will be provided to help you in the process.

3. Schedule a meeting with David Swanger to go over the ministry idea. Together you will discuss whether or not it meets the above criteria.
4. If it is decided that it does, the proposal will be passed on to us and we will do one of two things within a week:
 - a. Give approval for you to begin the ministry; or
 - b. Schedule a meeting with both you and David Swanger to clarify any questions we might have.

Again, we do not want to restrict you and your service. This is simply a means of transitioning into ministries in a smooth and efficient way. It will also help in preventing any new ministry taking away from or duplicating an already existing ministry. We always want to be aware of what is taking place, who is being served, and that it is done in a scriptural context, with love and consideration for all involved.
