# Barber Clippings

## Are You Too Old to Dream?

What are your plans for today? Is there something you anticipate for the future? Do you look forward to the days and weeks ahead?

Caleb was eighty-five years old when he asked for the mountain (Joshua 14:6-14). Although he had been rejected and ignored forty-five years earlier, he had not lost his dream.

Too often people lose hope when they get older. Someone wrote in *Reader's Digest*, "When you're young, you want to be the master of your fate and the captain of your soul. When you're older, you'll settle for being the master of your weight and the captain of your bowling team" (January 1996, page 111).

It's never too late to ask for the "mountain" when I realize the Lord is with me. God gave me the ability to think, to plan, and to be significant. Tony Campolo suggested three important questions to ask and answer:

1. If I'm going to be a person I can live with: *What kind of person am I going to be?*
2. If I'm going to do something meaningful with my life: *What kind of work should I do?*
3. And as my life comes to an end: *What do I want my legacy to be? (Everything You've Heard Is Wrong, page 19).*
4. If I want my children and grandchildren to plan, the best thing I can do is let them see me working toward worthy goals. They are watching and wondering.

While driving my nine-year-old to school, I asked him which high school he'd like to attend. He reminded me he was only in fourth grade. Seeing that I was getting his goat, I then asked him what college he planned to attend. Getting more annoyed, he said he didn't know. A minute later he said he wanted to pose a question to me.

"Fine," I replied.  
"Dad," he asked, "what cemetery would you like to be buried in?" (James A. Carolan, *Reader's Digest*, June 2000, pages 137, 138).

More important than selecting the cemetery plot is planning for the move after the cemetery. Caleb wanted the mountain. He knew he could have it with God's help. With God's blessing, we will be able to have heaven!
